## Update on shooting; LG woman freezes

A 48-year-old Locust Grove woman was found frozen to death on Sunday morning in the yard of her home east of Locust Grove, and a 56-year-old Langley man was jailed after a Saturday night shooting at his home.

Carnelia Ann Pruet, who was being treated for cancer, was discovered in her yard by her husband, according to Mayes County Sheriff's Investigator Albert McKee, who said the sheriff's office as

contacted at 6:30 a.m.

No foul play is suspected.

"It was apparently a normal pattern for her to get up at night and go outside," said McKee.

■ Donald Francis of Langley, a wheelchair-bound suspect, was booked into the jail on suspicion of shooting with intent to kill.

Billy Squirrel was shot twice in the abdomen by Francis at Francis' home

(585 S. Second St.) Saturday night where the two had spent time drinking alcohol during the day.

Francis fired three shots (.380 caliber semi-automatic pistol) through a glass window at the front of the house toward Squirrel who was on the front porch.

Squirrel has been through surgery and is expected to survive the shooting, according to Langley Police Chief Gary Hitchcock.
