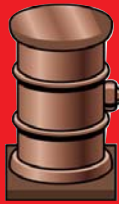

FREE TOURS OF PENSACOLA DAM ALL SUMMER

Free tours of Pensacola Dam are offered every day, including the Fourth of July - from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. - through Labor Day. Tours originate from the visitor center inside the GRDA Lake Patrol Headquarters on the west end (Langley) of the structure built between 1938 and 1940. The span built by Depression-era labor, is one of the largest multiple-arch dams in the world. Tourists can expect to view a short video on the dam's history inside the visitor's center before touring the powerhouse of the facility which still produces low-cost hydroelectric power.
